



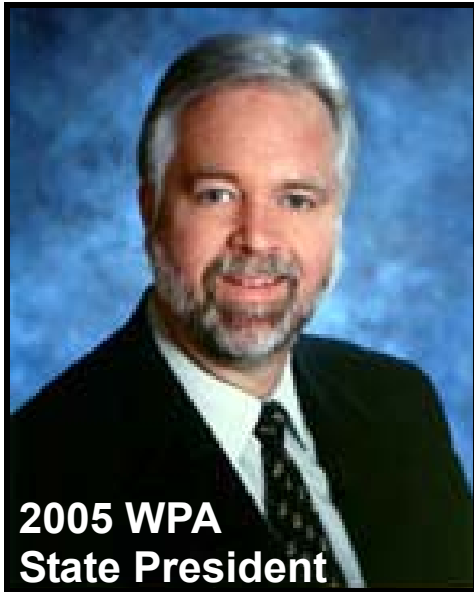

## March Against Hunger in Snohomish County

The County, Airport and the Volunteers of America (VOA) are working together to collect non-perishable food and cash donations to help feed the hungry in our region. In the past 6 years, 1.49 million pounds of food were donated to 20 local food banks that serve 460,000 hungry Snohomish County residents annually.
