Paine Field Fire Fighters have spent the last six months upgrading a 1986 Oshkosh T-3000 donated by SeaTac. Over 800 hours were devoted to dismantling, repairing, replacing, sanding and painting the “new” truck. It is now in service and is a near-exact duplicate of the other T-3000 donated by SeaTac in 2001. New equipment like this costs about \$1 million, so this recycling project provides great value to the Airport and the County. The pride of ownership is obvious. A huge thank you to the Port of Seattle for their generous donation and to the Paine Field Fire Fighters for all the sweat equity in giving the Osh a new lease on life.

## Korry Electronics Relocates to Paine Field

**Korry Electronics** recently announced that it will relocate from Seattle to available property at Snohomish County Paine Field Airport. They manufacture specialized aerospace interfaces for cockpits. Under the agreement, Capstone Partners will lease 14 acres of land for 55 years. Capstone will build a 250,000 square-foot building for lease to Korry. Construction is slated to begin in August.
