Airfield Security

Recently, one of our tenants gave his gate card to a friend with directions to his hangar. The friend had not received training or certification on airfield procedures and drove across an active runway causing a runway incursion. Unfortunately, this is not the first incident of this type. Please remember that your gate card is issued to you and you only. Every person that has been issued a gate card has also signed a statement that the gate card will not be given to another person. This means, for safety reasons, you do not loan out or give your card to anyone. If it is determined that a gate card is being used improperly, the access for that card may be removed. In addition, the code of the day should be treated with the same security consciousness as your gate card—do not provide to anyone who should not have access to the airfield.
