Air Traffic Control Tower Tips Radio Failure

The Airman's Information Manual suggests that you remain outside or above the airport traffic area until the direction and flow of traffic has been determined, then join the airport traffic pattern and maintain visual contact with the tower to receive light signals. Acknowledge the light signals and follow the instructions. The Federal Aviation Regulations require you to have a clearance to land. It helps to squawk 7600, the no-radio code, and prior to entering the airport traffic area. Also, the tower will broadcast instructions "in the blind" in case you are able to receive. If you can hear our calls, acknowledge by rocking your wings after each call. After landing, again watch for a light gun signal for taxi authorization. Boeing Aircraft Parking On Paine Field

During the flight test program for the new 787 and 747-8 aircraft, Boeing plans to temporarily store 15 new airplanes outside the normal Boeing ramp areas. The temporary storage will be on Kilo North by the Future of Flight, the Outer Terminal Ramp by the FAA Air Traffic Control Tower, Runway 11/29 and the South Ramp east of the new Fire Station. This parking may will last up to ten months. The storage is necessary to accommodate customer delivery schedules and adhere to 747-8 and 787 Dreamliner flight-test schedules. Any activities that create noise will be performed during the normal daytime hours and will comply with the County noise ordinance. No planned activities that produce audible community noise will be performed overnight.
