Mediated Role Determination Review

County Executive Aaron Reardon has asked the mayors of Mukilteo and Everett to co-chair a review of the 27-year old Mediated Role Determination (MRD) adopted by Snohomish County in 1978-79. Executive Reardon proposed the MRD Review at a meeting of Save Our Communities. He told the 300+ people at the meeting that he continues to back the MRD, but that misinterpretations of the document over nearly 30 years mean its review is long overdue. The MRD provides for updates, but none have been conducted in recent years. Specifics on the membership of the review panel and timeline have not been made available.

Central Ramp Hangars to be painted

The Airport will paint the exterior of the Central Ramp hangars this summer, with work starting June 6th. All of the hangar buildings will be pressure washed, prepped, primed, and finally painted to prolong building life and enhance the look of the buildings. For Central Ramp & old West Ramp hangars Effective August 1, 2005

T-hangar rental rates for the standard 40' T-hangars will increase \$10.00 a month from \$230.00 to \$240.00 per month effective Aug. 1, 2005.
