New Taxiway Kilo 1

The Airport will open bids on June 6 for the construction of the new Kilo 1 taxiway and Future of Flight parking apron.

This new 1000' long taxiway will connect at the threshold of runway 16R and go west towards the Future of Flight. There will also be a new concrete parking apron built adjacent to the Future of Flight to accommodate aircraft deliveries and other special events.

Construction should begin late June and continue until October. During construction, the Glideslope to runway 16R will shutdown in July for about three months due to the grading and paving activities taking place in the glideslope critical area. However, the localizer will be in operation the entire time.

Additionally, the runway 16R threshold will be relocated 1500' south for approximately 3 weeks in August, leaving 7,500' of runway available for takeoff and landing.

NEW HANGAR RENTAL RATES

Effective August 1, 2006

Central Ramp/Old West Ramp Hangars: T-hangar rental rates for the standard 40' T-hangars will increase to \$255.00 per month effective August 1, 2006. This includes state leasehold excise tax. Non-standard hangars and storerooms will have a similar percentage rate adjustment.

New West Ramp Hangars: Rates for the New West Ramp Hangars will receive a 3 year stepped rent adjustment effective August 1, 2006; August 1, 2007 and August 1, 2008. Tenants for the New West Ramp Hangars will receive a separate mailing on this rate change.
