Flying Heritage Collection

Flying Heritage Collection Fly Days started on GA Day in May and will continue through September on various Saturdays at noon. The Collection is housed in Hangar 207 on the south end of the Airport—it is only 100 yards from the main runway and the public can watch the Fly Day events for free. Ten of the aircraft are certified to fly by the FAA and scheduled as follows:

- 6/6 Bf-109 and Storch
- 6/20 P-40 Tomahawk and 1-16 Rata
- 6/27 Hurricane and P-51
- 7/18 Bf-109 and P-47 Thunderbolt
- 7/25 Spitfire and Hurricane
- 8/8 P-40 Tomahawk and Jenny
- 8/22 P-51 and P-47 Thunderbolt
- 9/12 1-16 Rata PO-2
- 9/19 Bf-109 and Storch

Admission to the Flying Heritage Collection (for a close up view of all the aircraft and discussions with docents) is \$12 for adults, \$10 for seniors and military and \$4 for children 6-16. Younger children are free.

New Hangar Rental Rates

Effective August 1, 2009

T-Hangar rental rates for the standard 40' T-Hangars will increase to \$280.00 effective August 1, 2009. This includes state leasehold excise tax. Non-standard hangars, storerooms and West Ramp hangars will have a similar percentage rate adjustment (less than 2%).

August statements will reflect the new rate and will also include the one-time increase in security deposit. The Airport will automatically deduct the new rate from autopay customers.
