GROUND BREAKING FOR NEW FIRE STATION

The ground breaking ceremony for a new Paine Field ARFF Station (Aircraft Rescue and Fire-fighting) was held on July 24. Aaron Reardon was among the local dignitaries hoisting a shovel.

The bid for the six million dollar project has been awarded to Bird Construction of Issaquah and completion is scheduled for April 2009. The new facility will replace the current Fire Station, a 60 year old structure that doesn't meet seismic standards, has no fire protection system and is inadequate for conducting operations.

The Paine Field Fire Department provides ARFF protection for all airfield operations, structural protection for all facilities and EMS (Emergency Medical Services).
