Runway Closure and Painting

Runway 16R-34L will be closed for maintenance from 9 p.m. on Friday, August 20 until 7 a.m. on Sunday, August 22.

During this closure, the Airport will perform minor asphalt repair and repainting of the entire main runway. The painting will involve the installation of surface painted hold signs and enhanced taxiway centerline markings at every runway intersection on the Airport. These new markings are an FAA initiative to help reduce runway incursions.
