## A Tribute to All Veterans At the Flying Heritage Collection

The **Flying Heritage Collection (FHC)** at Paine invites the public to attend "Flying Heroes of World War II" on **FLYING HERITAGE COLLECTION** Veterans Day, Tuesday, November 11. This special event will commemorate the courage, innovation and sacrifice of WWII veterans, with features such as a reunion of World War II fighter pilots; a panel of veterans and experts discussing the evolution and impact of military aviation; and a ceremony led by Lieutenant Governor Brad Owen, FHC Executive Director Adrian Hunt and historians Cory Graff and Andrew Himes. The event starts at 11am, and the Collection will be open all day.

FHC was founded by philanthropist Paul G. Allen, and is one of the world's great assemblies of rare World War II-era military aircraft. The collection includes many fighters that are nearly the last of their kind, restored impeccably with original materials. This isn't just a static air museum, either; these beauties are also being painstakingly returned to flying condition.

As a special thank-you to veterans for their service to our country, they will be given complimentary entrance to FHC on November 11. For non-veterans, admission rates are: Adults: \$12; seniors: \$10; youths (6-15), \$8; children (5 and under) free; and groups (15 or more): \$10 per person. Free parking is available outside the hangar at 3407 109th Street SW, Everett.

## Reminder to tenants: vehicle parking
