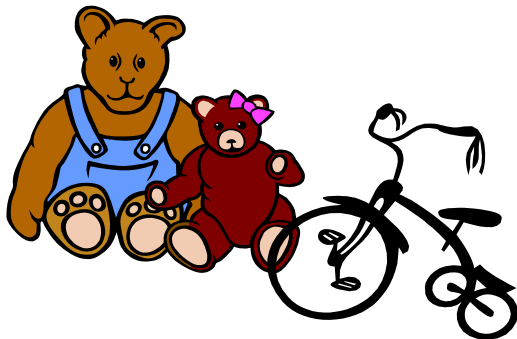

The weather outside is frightful.....

This is the Airport's annual reminder for those with airplane tie downs. Please ensure that you keep your aircraft properly secured. There have been several past instances where aircraft have been damaged during high wind storms because they were not properly tied down. It is the responsibility of the Aircraft Owner to ensure the aircraft is properly secured.

This is also the time of year when snow creates complications! The Airport has limited amounts of personnel and equipment. Our first priority is to keep 16R-34L and taxiway Alpha open. As our workload permits, we also try to plow the rest of the Airport's runways and taxiways. However, heavy workloads or a forecast that says the snow will melt within a day or two may mean that we are unable to get to a particular runway or taxiway. During every snowstorm, the Airport receives phone calls from pilots asking us to plow in front of their hangar so they can go flying. Please remember that this is not always possible, and there are times where there may be significant delays before we can get to you. The Airport is not responsible for plowing leased areas, but we will continue to plow when possible. Remember that plowing a single path to a hangar creates numerous other problems such as drifts and berms that take an inordinate amount of time to clean up. Please be patient.

**CHANGES FOR
HANGAR WAIT LIST**

As of February 1, 2005, the Airport will change the Hangar Wait List Policy to better facilitate those tenants actively pursuing a hangar at Paine Field. This new policy will affect both new and existing Hangar Wait List tenants.

The Airport will continue to require a separate hangar deposit for each size hangar requested. Effective February 1, 2005, the application fee will increase to \$100. The deposit will then be applied to the first month's rent when a hangar becomes available for rent. Existing Hangar Wait List tenants will be sent a new application and an invoice for the additional \$75 in mid-December. In addition, the Airport will charge a non-refundable \$10 annual administrative fee. All future correspondences will be by mail. It will continue to be important for all perspective tenants to maintain current contact information. All other changes and amendments can be viewed at our website: www.painefield.com or by calling the Airport Office for a copy of the latest Policy and Application.

Again, in order to join or remain on the Hangar Wait List, all perspective and existing Wait List tenants must have all contact information updated, a Wait List Application completed, and the \$100 deposit paid in full by February 1, 2005.
