### **Paine Field Air Traffic Control Tips**

#### **AIRPORT TRAFFIC AREA**

There have been a few instances of aircraft entering Paine Field traffic areas without having first established two-way radio communications with the tower. This is potentially dangerous. If you have an operable radio, and you are unable to get in on the frequency, remain outside of the Class Delta airspace until you can establish proper contact. Don't keep flying inbound hoping that you'll get in on frequency soon. An aircraft entering the Class Delta unannounced is in violation of the FARs and creates a very unsafe situation.
